04. HOW WILL THE TRAINERS ADDRESS THEIR TRAINEES AFTER COMPLETION OF THE TRAINING?

05. WHAT WERE THE TOTAL NUMBER OF REGISTERED DISPUTES / FIGHTS BETWEEN TRAINERS [JUNIOR IN RANK] AND THEIR TRAINEES [OFFICERS, MUCH SENIOR IN RANK]?

06. IS THERE A MANUAL REGARDING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN TRAINERS AND TRAINEES? IF YES, KINDLY PROVIDE A COPY OF THE SAME. IF NO, WHY?
