Smt. Maneka Sanjay Gandhi, Union Minister for Women and Child Development, inaugurated, on 5th May, 2017, a workshop on Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition & Redressal) Act, 2013. Chairpersons and members of the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) of PMO, Cabinet Secretariat and all Central Ministries and Departments were the participants in the workshop. The participants were also addressed by Smt. Krishna Raj, Minister of State for Women and Child Development and Dr. Sunita H. Khurana, Director ISTM.

During the workshop, Smt. Mayuri Raghuvanshi, Advocate, Supreme Court of India and Sh. Sanjeev Kumar, Deputy Secretary, Department of Personnel and Training interacted with the participants and clarified many doubts relating to the Act. It concluded by emphasizing upon the chairpersons and participating members of Internal Complaints Committee the need to be extremely serious in addressing the grievances of women on their sexual harassment at workplace.
